2. Must have demonstrated a willingness to make a positive contribution to their communities.
3. Attach high school transcript. (Please send with application. **DO NOT** send separately.)
4. Must have **ONLY** 2 (two) letters of recommendation (1 (one) from a teacher, the other should **not** be school related **nor** a relative of the applicant.)
5. Attach an essay based on the following three questions. **Essay must be 250 words or less.**
 1. How do you see going to college having an impact on your life?
 2. What are your goals as they pertain to a career in the Cable & Telecommunication industry?
 3. Why should we grant you this scholarship?
